A new, ingenious accessory for the RECARO Monza (Seatfix): the RECARO footrest

Marktleugast / Germany, September 2009. Since 1998 RECARO has been offering a footrest for its successful model, the RECARO Start. Now this comfortable and practical accessory is also available for the two seats RECARO Monza and RECARO Monza Seatfix.

Most children up to the age of twelve spend a quite a bit of time in the car. So, to facilitate a more comfortable and enjoyable seat for the child, there is the RECARO footrest. The height of the footrest, made of stable, unscratchable plastic and the aluminium support leg can be adjusted independently of each other. What's more, the depth of the footrest can be adjusted to fit the length of the child's thigh. Comfortably bent legs and feet that rest flat on the footrest ensure better blood circulation in the child's legs.

The footrest is easy to fix in place. First, the two round covers on the front of the seat must be removed. The footrest then simply clicks into one of the four recesses in the seat. The footrest for the RECARO Monza and the RECARO Monza Seatfix will be available at specialist shops as of November 2009.
